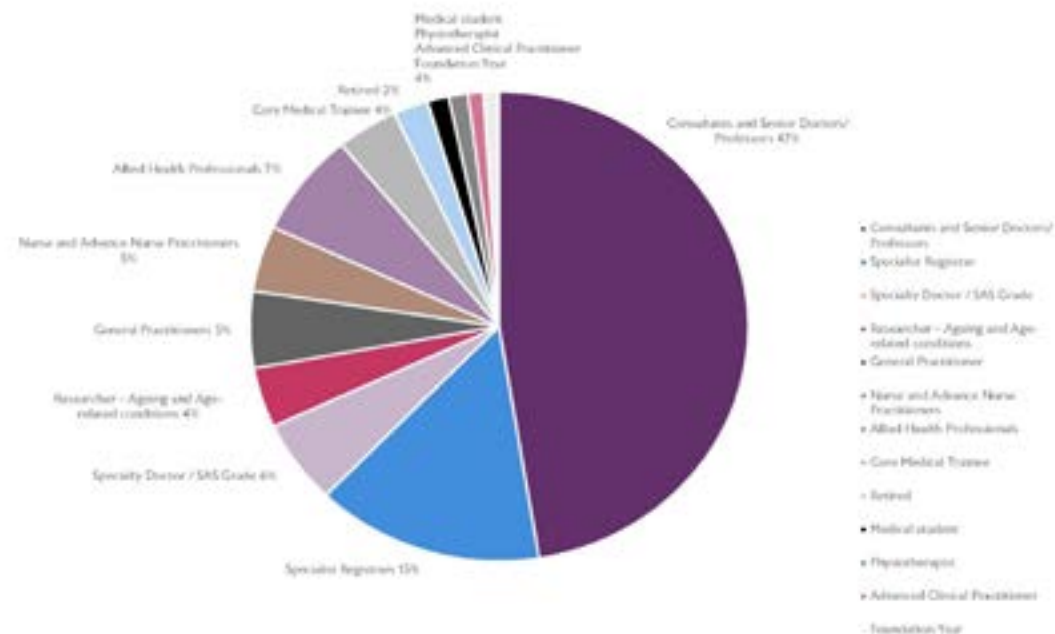
Spring and Autumn Partnership Packages

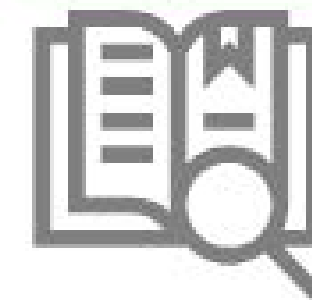

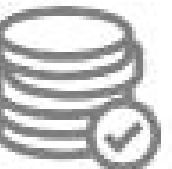
